



Academic Staff Remuneration and Benefits Scale (“Lichfield Scale”)

Stipend £27,240

Grants & Allowances

Accommodation – A house is provided free of rent and Council Tax, or a housing allowance currently £9,600 p.a.

Free meals – Provided during term-time

Car allowance – Annual allowance towards the cost of maintaining a car currently £1,800 p.a.

Membership of an appropriate Professional organisation or Learned Society

Books – Re-imbursment of cost of Theological books up to a maximum of £768 in any one year

Pension – Contribution towards the Church of England Pension Scheme.

Re-settlement grant £2,527 (this is additional to the actual cost of removal i.e., “the van”)

The period of working hours is determined first and foremost by our shared commitment to the common life. This involves being at morning and evening prayer Monday – Friday (7.30am and 6.00pm) and Mattins and the Eucharist on Sunday (7.30am and 8.00am), and to shared meals. As with parish life, there is a fair degree of flexibility about the working day and there is a marked difference between the term time and the vacations.

The post holder would be expected to visit local parishes where students are on placement, these vary from rural to city centre, and are usually within ½ hrs drive from College.
